





IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Site Evaluation Committee for the State of New Hampshire shall conduct public meeting and hearing on January 29, 2010 at 10 A.M. at the office of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 10, Concord, N.H. The Agenda for said Public Meeting and Hearing is as follows:

Docket No. 2008-02 Application of Tennessee Gas Pipeline for a Certificate of Site and Facility for the Concord Lateral Expansion Project. The complaint of Carol M. Desrosiers regarding Noise Level Testing; and any other matters that may legally come before the committee.

The Proceeding

On March 19, 2009, the Committee issued a Certificate of Site and Facility (Certificate) to Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (Tennessee) to site, construct, install and operate a new 6,130 horsepower compression station on a line 200 system (also known as the Concord Lateral System or Lateral) in Lham, New Hampshire. In addition, the Certificate permitted Tennessee to upgrade its existing "Laconia Meter Station" (Meter Station) in Concord, New Hampshire with piping modifications to accommodate additional capacity. The Certificate authorized the Applicant to construct, operate and maintain the Station so that it remains in full compliance with applicable FERC sound level regulations. As a condition of the Certificate the Committee retained its authority to monitor the proposed facility, to investigate complaints and to enforce the terms and conditions of the Certificate of Site and Facility, including the authority to require further sound level testing or additional remedial measures. On December 23, 2009, Carol M. Desrosiers filed a letter of complaint with the Committee asserting that the noise survey was incomplete. At this hearing the Committee will determine what action, if any, should be taken with regard to Ms. Desrosiers' letter of complaint. Tennessee shall file its response to Ms. Desrosiers' letter with the Committee on or before January 19, 2010. This hearing is conducted pursuant to RSA 162-B:4.

Public Inspection

The letter from Ms. Desrosiers and all other correspondence, filings, and public orders regarding this matter are available for public inspection at the Office of the Chairman of the Committee located at the Department of Environmental Services, 92 Hazen Drive, Concord, New Hampshire and on the Committee's web site at www.nhsec.nh.gov.

It is further ordered that a copy of this Order and Notice of Public Hearing and Meeting shall be served, via first class mail, to all parties participating in the mentioned docket. Tennessee shall see this Order of Notice of Public Hearing and Meeting to be published on or before January 15, 2010, in a newspaper of general circulation in Merrimack and Hillsborough Counties. Tennessee shall file affidavits attesting to said publication with the Chairman of the Committee on or before January 22, 2010.
