REQUEST OF GRANITE RIDGE ENERGY LLC FOR A  
DECLARATORY RULING REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COLD  
STORAGE FACILITY AT ITS CERTIFICATED FACILITY IN LONDONDERRY, N.H.

On July 8, 2008, the Site Evaluation Committee received correspondence from Attorney Douglas Patch on behalf of Granite Ridge Energy, LLC (GRE). GRE plans to build an addition to its facility in Londonderry, New Hampshire for the purpose of cold storage. The addition would be 52 feet by 55 feet with total floor space of 2,750 square feet. GRE attached certain drawings to its request.

GRE requests that the Committee declare that the proposed addition is not a sizable addition requiring an additional Certificate of Site and Facility pursuant to R.S.A. 162-H: 5, I.

This matter will be presented to the Committee for discussion at its public meeting scheduled for July 17, 2008 at 11:30 A.M.
