In Case No. 2010-0121, Appeal of Campaign for Ratepayers' Rights & a., the court on April 15, 2010, issued the following order:

Public Service Company of New Hampshire's motion for summary dismissal is denied.

Appeal from a decision of the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee is accepted and will be scheduled for oral argument before the full court.

Case is accepted. This case appears to be eligible for mediation pursuant to Rule 12-A. Under Rule 12-A(2), the agreement of all parties is required for appellate mediation. If all parties in this case agree to participate in mediation, Attorney Eggleton for TransCanada Hydro Northeast, Inc. shall submit the completed Appellate Mediation Agreement form to the court on or before May 3, 2010. An Appellate Mediation Agreement form (NHJB-2614-SUP) is being provided to Attorney Eggleton with this order. If an Appellate Mediation Agreement form is not filed, an order will be issued regarding further proceedings.
