Dear Chairman Burack:

We are registered voters in Gorham and Berlin, New Hampshire. We are attaching petitions from registered voters from these two communities. We are asking that the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee review the proposed Clean Power Development Project in Berlin.


We find ourselves in the fortunate position of having not one, but two serious biomass projects proposed in our region. We are anxious to see the available resources of the area put to use in a way that will maximize employment opportunities and economic growth while balancing environmental concerns. However, while one project will be thoroughly examined by the Site Evaluation Committee, the other has apparently been designed to fall just short of the Committee's jurisdiction. Concerned citizens will thus have confidence that one project will receive appropriate scrutiny, but will have little information by which to evaluate the merits of the other.

There are several issues associated with the Clean Power project that have received scant attention but which would get a proper airing through the SEC process. For instance, the proposed plant would require heavy trucks to travel through neighborhoods on roads not designed for such traffic. The plan envisions several ancillary projects, such as the cultivation of algae in wastewater treatment discharge that would be fed into the plant for combustion. The plant's cooling towers would also utilize wastewater treatment discharge. It is also impossible for the community to gauge the financial viability of a project like this and therefore evaluate their prospects for sustained operation.


None of these issues should necessarily prevent the Clean Power project from moving forward. But without the proper level of scrutiny, it's difficult for the community to properly understand the potential impact, good or bad, of this proposed plant. Your Committee is in the ideal position to ensure that questions about the project's impact on the environment, jobs and the economy, as well as about its financial viability, are appropriately addressed.

As you know, state law has a provision to address community interest in a proposed plant: under RSA 162-H:2, VII (g), we understand that if two or more petitioners, supported by signatures of one hundred registered voters in the host community and abutting community, ask the Site Evaluation Committee to review a project, it will consider doing so. We think the Clean Power Project requires your Committee's review and we also believe that the residents of Berlin and Gorham would benefit significantly if your Committee assessed the project. There is precedent, as we understand from a recent presentation in Berlin by Tim Drew that the Site Evaluation Committee took jurisdiction of the wind project in Lempster even though it was only in the neighborhood of 24 megawatts.

Thank you very much for your attention to this important matter.
