NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Site Evaluation Committee for the State of New Hampshire shall conduct a public meeting on February 3, 2010, at 9 A.M., at the office of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 10, Concord, N.H. The Agenda for said Public Meeting is as follows:

Docket No. 2009-03 Petitions of Michael Laflamme and Howard Jones (including 116 Registered Voters from Berlin and 104 Registered Voters from Gorham) for Review of a 29 MW Biomass Power Plant Developed by Clean Power Development, LLC and Located in Berlin, Coos County, New Hampshire

On November 25, 2009, Michael Laflamme and Howard Jones each filed a petition with the Site Evaluation Committee (Committee) entitled Petition for the Site Evaluation Committee to Rule on the Clean Power Development, LLC Berlin Project (collectively referred to as the Petition or Petitions). Each Petition was endorsed by more than one hundred registered voters from the City of Berlin and the Town of Gorham. Each petition requested the Committee to review the Clean Power Development project proposed for Shelby Street, in Berlin, New Hampshire. The project consists of a 29 MW biomass fueled electric generating station and certain ancillary facilities.

On January 28, 2010, the Committee held a duly noticed public hearing on the Petitions. At the conclusion of the presentation of evidence by the parties and hearing public comment, the Chairman of the Committee recessed the hearing until February 3, 2010, at 9:00 A.M. for the purpose of deliberating on whether to grant or deny the Petitions.

Please take notice that the continuation of the public meeting will occur commencing at 9:00 A.M. at the office of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit, Suite 10, Concord, N.H. The purpose for the continuation of the public meeting is for deliberation by the Committee. No further evidence or public comment will be heard.
