Dear Commissioner Burack,

We hereby apply for intervenor status at the Site Evaluation Committee concerning Groton Wind LLC.

We are convinced that our rights, duties, privileges, immunities and other substantial interests will be adversely affected by this project.

We are Rumney residents, abutters to the Groton Wind Project. From the back of our house, 774 Quincy Road, we will be in full view of the 12 wind turbines planned to go on the ridges of Fletcher Mtn. Consequently, we stand to be greatly affected by the impacts of such an industrial wind installation. From the records, we know that we will have to deal with the adverse health effects, known as Wind Turbine Syndrome, created by the never ending noise, vibrations, reverberations and low frequency soundwaves emitted by these machines. We will be subjected to shadowflicker from the turning blades and to lightflicker from aircraft warning lights. We also read about the increased risk for forest fires posed by wind turbines, which contain 500 gallons of oil for lubrication. We hear about ice throws, metal fatigue, braking blades turning into projectiles, etc. We also know that in the presence of these gigantic looming machines our property values will collapse and the price of electricity will increase.
