**AGENDA FOR TECHNICAL SESSION**

**A Technical Session will be held in this docket commencing on August 9, 2010 and continuing through August 10, 2010. The Technical Session shall commence each day at 9:00 A.M. The Technical Session shall be held at the Department of Fish and Game (Large Conference Room) located at 11 Hazen Drive, Concord N.H., 03301.**

This Technical Session will be an informal opportunity for the parties to ask questions of the Applicant's witnesses who have filed testimony in this matter. The following rules and procedures shall apply:

**1. Schedule of Witnesses.** During the Technical Session the Applicant's witnesses will be available for questions as follows:

Monday August 9, 2010:

11:00 A.M. Panel: Edwar Cherian, Nancy Rendall, and Adam Gravel (Issues include natural environment, wetlands, wildlife, mapping, avian and bat studies.)

1:00 P.M. – 2:00 P.M. Lunch break.

2:00 P.M. Panel: Edward Cherian, Pablo Canales (telephonically), Kevin Devlin (telephonically) (Issues include financial, managerial and technical capabilities.)

5:00 P.M. Adjourn

Tuesday August 10, 2010:

9:00 A.M. Panel: Edward Cherian and Hope Luhman (Issues included historic sites and properties.)

10:30 A.M. Panel: Edward Cherian and John Hecklau (Issues include aesthetics, visual impacts, public health and safety.)

1:00 P.M. Panel: Edward Cherian and Robert O’Neal (Issues include sound impacts, noise and public health and safety.)

The allotted time frames are estimated only and the questioning period for each witness may vary. Witnesses should be advised that the time frames may vary. The schedule is also subject to change.

**2. Order of Inquiry.** The order of inquiry for each panel of witnesses shall be as follows:

- iii. Town of Rumney

- v. Buttolph intervenors
- vi. Mazur intervenors

**3. Procedures.** Inquiries shall be in a question form and shall not be argumentative. Repetitive questions or inquiries will not be allowed. Questions and inquires to witnesses should be limited to issues pertaining to the witness’s field of expertise and pre-filed testimony. Questions regarding qualifications of witnesses will also be allowed. If a proper question or inquiry cannot be answered at the time of the Technical Session, the Applicant will, in accordance with pre-trial scheduling order, prepare a written follow up answer and provide said written answers and responsive documents by August 17, 2010.

**4. Counsel for the Committee.** Counsel for the Committee will mediate any disputes regarding inquiries and requests for information and will maintain a list of documents that should be provided to the parties by August 17, 2010, in accordance with the pre-trial scheduling order. To the extent that any party is aggrieved by the handling of any inquiry, question or document request, that party shall file an appropriate motion for discovery, objection to discovery or motion for a protective order. Said motions and/or objections shall be directed to the presiding officer and shall comply with the Committee’s Procedural Rules and the pre-trial order issued in this docket.
