Comments on Proposed Wind Farm in Groton:

New Hampshire is a state blessed with great natural beauty. Our lakes, hills, ridges and mountains are a joy and an inspiration to residents and visitors alike. The prospect of having our scenic vistas spoiled by gigantic turbines, with spinning blades reflecting light, and by flashing lights at night, fills us with great sadness. Wind turbines are appropriate in sites such as open plains and deserts, and offshore in the ocean, but in our opinion, not in the New Hampshire mountains. Sources of clean power such as solar arrays, and hydroelectric power from Canada, are far better options. We also object to foreign companies taking advantage of government subsidies to create wind farms with little personal interest in the visual impact. They will not live in the vicinity of these turbines. We respectfully urge the Committee to reject the proposed wind farm, and to keep our hills and mountains free from the visual pollution these turbines would create.
