The Division of Historical Resources (Division) is in receipt of a request for review for the End-of-Field Letter, Addendum Phase IB Archaeological Survey cited above prepared and submitted by Dr. Luhman of The Louis Berger Group, Inc. The Division concurs with the recommendations provided and finds the information acceptable as written.

Based upon the information provided in the above cited End-of-Field Letter, it has been determined that there are no known properties of archaeological significance within the area of the undertaking's potential impact and no further identification or evaluative studies are recommended.

If any archeological resources are discovered or affected as a result of project planning or implementation, the Division is to be consulted on the need for appropriate evaluative studies, determinations of National Register eligibility, and mitigative measures (redesign, resource protection, or data recovery) as required by federal law and regulations. Also, as plans change consultation with the Division will be required.
