ADDENDUM
TO ORDER AND NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On September 4, 2013, the Site Evaluation Committee (Committee), through its Chairperson, issued an Order and Notice of Prehearing Conference in the above entitled matter. The prehearing conference is scheduled for October 2, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. and will be held at the offices of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission, 21 Fruit Street, Suite 10, Concord, New Hampshire.

The Corrected Order and Notice of Hearing indicated that the prehearing conference will cover issues regarding safety and maintenance of the turbine roads and the issue of the location of the operation and maintenance building. However, on August 14, 2013, counsel for the Committee received a letter from Investigator Ron Anstey of the State Fire Marshal Office. In his letter, Investigator Anstey alleges that statements made in testimony by the Applicant's representatives at the time of the adjudicatory hearing were not true. In addition, Investigator Anstey's letter alleges that the Applicant has failed to comply with applicable fire and building codes and, therefore, has failed to comply with the decision granting a Certificate of Site and Facility with conditions in the above docketed matter. Investigator Anstey has recommended that all operation on the site cease until all safety concerns, plans, reviews, and required inspections have been completed and approved.

In addition to the matters set forth in the Corrected Order and Notice of Hearing, the issues raised by Investigator Anstey will be addressed at the prehearing conference as well.

All parties should be prepared to engage, in a productive manner, to settle outstanding issues, if possible. In the event that resolution of outstanding issues is not possible, all parties should be prepared to address a discovery and a procedural schedule for the balance of the pending proceedings including an adjudicative hearing at which the Committee may consider suspension of the Certificate of Site and Facility pursuant to RSA 162-H: 12.
