Dear Chairman Burack:

I, Mario Rampino Jr., petition the Site Evaluation Committee under RSA 541-A:32, to allow me to intervene on the Groton Wind matter due to the following :

1. My property, (Lot 16-2-10) abuts the Project site.
2. My property has suffered great harm due to the changes from the original plan submitted in the Application, to the revised plans of 10/28/11. These changes included the movement of the O & M building, as well as a filtration basin. My home, which was my private sanctuary, is now overshadowed by an industrial building which looms above my property, rendering it almost worthless. In addition, the filtration basin was put so close to my property line, during a storm event in early 2012 it filled, causing the water to discharge and contaminate my well. To this day, I am not able to drink from it.
3. Due to the changes in the location of the O & M building, I have absolutely no privacy and no longer use my yard.
4. Due to the changes in the location of the O & M building, filtration basin and road for the Groton Wind project, the continuous noise and constant traffic prevent me from enjoying my home.
5. I was not notified of these changes, nor was I given an opportunity to voice my concerns of the impact these changes would have on my property.

I believe my personal rights and interests will be affected by the proceedings. By allowing my intervention, I will not disrupt the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings.
