

so burdensome, the documents so voluminous, or the issues so complex, a month for this effort seems unreasonable.

4. The request did not represent that an effort had been made to consult with parties other than the Fire Marshal. N.H. Admin. R. Site 202.14(d) requires such an effort be made.

5. Counsel for the Public does not object to a reasonable extension of time and submits that March 14, 2014 is a reasonable extension.

Wherefore, because the movant has not demonstrated cause for its request, Counsel for the Public prays that the Committee deny the request to extend, and grant such other and further relief as may be just.
