

Dear Susan:

I am writing in my capacity as legal counsel for the Town of Rumney.

As we discussed this morning by telephone, notwithstanding the March 24, 2014 letter to your client Groton Wind LLC from the Town's Selectmen, the Selectmen do not believe that the Town of Rumney *per se* (as a municipality) has any outstanding issue with Groton Wind LLC at the present time. To any extent that letter implied otherwise, such implications are now withdrawn.

That being the case, the Selectmen do not believe a "settlement" meeting on Friday is necessary.

The Town of course reserves its right to raise any issue which might arise in the future concerning the Agreement between your client and the Town, or under any applicable SEC orders.
