**ASSENTED TO MOTION TO REVISE SCHEDULE**

Counsel for the Public, by his attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General, hereby moves the Committee to revise the dates in the procedural order by pushing each date out 30 days. In support hereof, Counsel for the Public represents as follows:

1. On February 20, 2014, the Chairman and Presiding Officer entered the Procedural order and Notice of Possible Suspension of Certificate of Site and Facility (the “Order”).
2. In the Order, there was established a “Procedural Schedule for Remaining Issues” and certain “Additional Deadlines” (the “Procedural Dates”). Order, pp. 3-5.
3. Groton Wind and Counsel for the Public have made an agreement in principle to resolve Counsel for the Public’s demand that the O&M Building be removed and certain other issues in the case.
4. The parties are attempting to resolve certain differences over documentation of the agreement.

5. Counsel for the Public and Groton Wind have agreed to move the scheduled dates by 30 days.
6. Groton Wind and Lisa Linowes have assented to the relief requested in this motion.

Wherefore, Counsel for the Public prays that the Committee revise the Order to move each of the Procedural dates out by thirty days, and grant such other and further relief as may be just.
