

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, Department of Safety, Office of the State Fire Marshal (hereinafter referred to as the "Department") by its attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General, and hereby submits this final status report regarding the compliance of Groton Wind, LLC (the "Applicant") with the Compliance Agreement and in support thereof states as follows:


1. The Department and the Applicant entered into a Compliance Agreement dated April 10, 2014 that was filed with the Committee.
2. The Department previously provided the Committee with a status report setting forth the Applicant's compliance with the Agreement dated June 9, 2014.
3. Since the filing of the last status update, the Applicant has completed all of the requirements of the Compliance Agreement to the satisfaction of the Fire Marshal.¹
4. Occupancy permits for the O & M building and each of the 24 towers were delivered to the Site on September 26, 2014.

¹With regard to the Lightning Protection System requirement set forth at paragraph 5 of the Compliance Agreement, the Department is satisfied that the applicable requirements of the Fire Code, including NFPA 780, have been met.


