

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

NOW COMES Susan S. Geiger, upon oath, being duly sworn, and states as follows:

1. I am counsel for the Petitioner, Antrim Wind Energy, LLC (“Antrim Wind”).
2. On March 21, 2011, the Site Evaluation Committee (“SEC”) Chairman issued an Order and Notice of Public Meeting in the above-captioned docket and in Docket No. 2011-01, an unrelated matter involving Laidlaw Berlin BioPower, LLC (“Laidlaw”). Among other things, the Order and Notice directed Laidlaw and AntrimWind to cause a copy of the Order and Notice to be published no later than April 1, 2011 in the New Hampshire Union Leader or New Hampshire Sunday News.
3. The above-referenced publication was made in the Union Leader on March 24, 2011. *See Affidavit of Barry Needleman*, Docket No. 2011-01 (March 31, 2011).
4. The Order and Notice also directed Antrim Wind to cause a copy of the Order and Notice to be published in a newspaper of regular circulation in the area of Antrim, Hillsborough County, on or before April 1, 2011, and to publish a display ad in that newspaper “advising the public of the date, time, place and subject matter of the public meeting in Docket Number 2011-02.” *Order and Notice of Public Meeting* (March 21, 2011), p. 4.

5. The Order and Notice was published on March 29, 2011 in the Monadnock Ledger-Transcript, a newspaper published in Peterborough, New Hampshire, and on April 1, 2011 in the Villager, a newspaper published in Hillsborough, New Hampshire. Copies of the published notices, along with affidavits/statements attesting to said publications are submitted herewith.

6. A display ad was published in the Monadnock Ledger-Transcript on March 29, 2011, and in the Villager on April 1, 2011. Copies of the published display ads, along with affidavits/statements attesting to said publications are submitted herewith.

7. Although the display ads correctly advised the public of the date, time, place and subject matter of the public meeting to be held April 22, 2011 in this docket, they incorrectly stated that the deadline for filing intervention motions is April 21, 2011 instead of the correct intervention deadline, April 15, 2011. The display ads also did not indicate the April 21, 2011 deadline for filing objections to intervention motions. Because Antrim Wind will not object (on the basis of tardiness) to interventions filed between April 15, 2011 and April 21, 2011, this publication error is harmless.

The New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee will conduct a public meeting at 9 a.m. on April 22, 2011 in Hearing Room A, at the Offices of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 10, Concord, New Hampshire. On November 8, 2010, the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee (Committee) issued a Certificate of Site and Facility (Certificate) to Laidlaw Berlin BioPower, LLC, for the siting, construction, and operation of a 70 MW biomass fueled power facility located in Berlin, Coos County, New Hampshire (Facility). On March 9, 2011, Laidlaw Berlin BioPower, LLC, and Berlin Station, LLC (Joint Applicants), filed a joint motion to amend the Certificate, to transfer the Certificate to Berlin Station, LLC, and to notify the Committee of a change in major contractors (Joint Motion). The Joint Applicants propose to transfer the Certificate to Berlin Station, LLC. Berlin Station, LLC, is a special purpose entity whose members are BBP Holdings 1, LLC (99%) and BBP Holdings 2, LLC (1%). BBP Holdings 1, LLC, is an indirect subsidiary of Newco Energy, LLC. BBP Holdings 2, LLC, is a subsidiary of CSC Group Holdings, LLC. Berlin Station, LLC, intends to execute a right of use agreement with Burgess BioPower, LLC, an indirect subsidiary of Newco Energy, LLC, permitting Burgess BioPower LLC to lease and manage the Facility and all certificates, licenses and contracts pertaining thereto.

In addition, the Joint Applicants seek to amend the Certificate to permit operation at 75 megawatts rather than 70 MW. The increase in output is asserted to be achieved through design efficiencies and will not require additional fuel.

The Joint Applicants further request that the Certificate be amended to permit a change in the fuel supply contractor. In the Motion, the Joint Applicants also notify the Committee of a change in major engineering and construction contractors. 
