

MOTION TO INTERVENE *PRO SE* OF SAMUEL E. & MICHELE D. APKARIAN

Pursuant to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee Rules Site 202.11, Samuel E. & Michele D. Apkarian hereby move for permission to intervene *pro se* in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of their Motion to Intervene, Samuel E. & Michele D. Apkarian offer the following arguments:

- (1.) Samuel E. & Michele D. Apkarian can demonstrate a substantial interest which may be affected by the outcome of the proceeding.**

We are concerned over property value, viewshed, noise, or health, etc. due to proximity, since our property and residence lies within one and one-half mile from and in view of the proposed wind turbine site.

- (2.) The interest of Samuel E. & Michele D. Apkarian will not be adequately protected by other parties.**


In exercising its discretion, we respectfully ask that the Committee consider whether the party's interest will be adequately protected by other parties. Since we, as residents of the North Branch region of Antrim where the proposed wind facility would be constructed, do not feel that our interests and concerns have been addressed thus far in proceedings by the Selectmen and Planning Board of Antrim, we do not believe that any other party to this proceeding can adequately represent our interests in proceedings before the Committee.

- (3.) The intervention of Samuel E. & Michele D. Apkarian will be in the interest of justice and will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings by allowing the intervention.**


