

**MOTION TO INTERVENE *PRO SE* OF James Hankard**

Pursuant to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee Rules Site 202.11, James Hankard hereby moves for permission to intervene *pro se* in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of his Motion to Intervene, James Hankard offers the following arguments:

**(1.) James Hankard can demonstrate a substantial interest which may be affected by the outcome of the proceeding.**

The town of Antrim has done its own planning for over thirty years and should not have this power or authority forfeited by any other entity. This project flies in the face of the town's master plan, specifically by violating and destroying the "Rural Conservation" area that former citizens took so long to design and create. The letter submitted by former selectman and former planning board member Mr. Gordon Webber was premature, contains only his signature and does not reflect the majority of the current Planning Board or the current Selectman or the town's people itself. The close proximity of this industrial wind farm project will have a profound negative impact on my overall health and well being. It will generate noise of a dangerous decibel level that will be intolerable for all those within a 2-mile radius.

The value of my home will most assuredly be negatively affected with me having no recourse to recoup this financial loss. The size and scope of this intended complex will dominant my life in a manner that in no way improves or enhances my way of life. The town itself will receive no benefit regarding its electrical expenses, and will actually see the price of electricity increase. There are also two pending court cases that need to be resolved that could stop the advancement of this monstrosity on its own. During all the meetings that I attended regarding this issue, neither the former Planning Board nor former Selectman allowed any town resident to present why they and others felt that this Wind Farm complex was not in residents' best interest.

**(2.) The interest of James Hankard will not be adequately protected by other parties.**

In exercising its discretion, I respectfully ask that the Committee consider whether the party's interest will be adequately protected by other parties. Since I, as a resident of the North Branch region of Antrim where the proposed wind facility would be constructed, do not feel that my interests and concerns have been addressed thus far in proceedings by the Selectmen and Planning Board of Antrim, I do not believe that any other party to this proceeding can adequately represent my interests in proceedings before the Committee.

**(3.) The intervention of James Hankard will be in the interest of justice and will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings by allowing the intervention.**

Pursuant to the SEC Order of March 21, 2011, James Hankard files this Motion to Intervene by the deadline set forth by the Committee for Docket 2011-02 and requests that I be permitted to intervene with full standing to participate in all phases and activities of the proceeding. I respect the importance of conducting this proceeding in an orderly manner that will not unduly delay the Committee or the parties in reaching an outcome. I am prepared to work closely with other parties to the proceeding in the interest of maintaining order and respectfully offer that my participation, if permitted, would be in the interest of justice.
