

MOTION TO INTERVENE *PRO SE* OF ELSA VOELCKER

Pursuant to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee Rules Site 202.11, Elsa Voelcker hereby moves for permission to intervene *pro se* in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of her Motion to Intervene, Elsa Voelcker offers the following arguments:

(1.) Elsa Voelcker can demonstrate a substantial interest which may be affected by the outcome of the proceeding.

I live within a mile of the end of the proposed wind project. I have lived here since 1983. In 1999-2000 I built an addition to my house planning on recouping the money I spent when I sold the house. I am now sixty-two and hoped to be able to retire when I am sixty-six. Now I find that I will not be able to realize what I have invested in my house. I have taken a ride over to Lempster and heard the sound of their similar wind towers. I know I will have to move. I hate motor noises and as I live west of the proposed wind farm I expect I will hear it often as that is the prevailing winds. I worry, too, about the flicker effect as the sun goes down each evening. I firmly believe that the company building this project should have to reimburse homeowners within two miles of the farm for the money they lose on their house if and when they are able to sell it. Such a mandate was made in a western New York State town.

(2.) The interest of Elsa Voelcker will not be adequately protected by other parties.

In exercising its discretion, I respectfully ask that the Committee consider whether the party's interest will be adequately protected by other parties. Since I, as a resident of the North Branch region of Antrim where the proposed wind facility would be constructed, do not feel that my interests and concerns have been addressed thus far in proceedings by the Selectmen and Planning Board of Antrim, I do not believe that any other party to this proceeding can adequately represent my interests in proceedings before the Committee.

(3.) The intervention of Elsa Voelcker will be in the interest of justice and will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings by allowing the intervention.

Pursuant to the SEC Order of March 21, 2011, Elsa Voelcker files this Motion to Intervene by the deadline set forth by the Committee for Docket 2011-02 and requests that I be permitted to intervene with full standing to participate in all phases and activities of the proceeding. I respect the importance of conducting this proceeding in an orderly manner that will not unduly delay the Committee or the parties in reaching an outcome. I am prepared to work closely with other parties to the proceeding in the interest of maintaining order and respectfully offer that my participation, if permitted, would be in the interest of justice.
