Mr. Burack,

We respectfully request that the state of N.H. Site Evaluation Committee rule against the Petition for Jurisdiction over a renewable energy facility by Antrim Wind Energy LLC for the following reasons:

- 1.) For over three decades the Antrim Planning and Zoning Board has addressed and instituted a number of diverse siting regulations including a comprehensive ordinance regarding the siting of residential wind turbines. The letter you received dated Feb. 10th 2011 from former selectman Gordan Webber is totally incorrect in his statement of Antrim's similarity to the Town of Lempster which has no Planning or Zoning Boards.
- 2.) Recently two new Planning Board members plus a new selectman have been elected by an over-whelming town majority vote indicating residents dissatisfaction with former selectmen and Planning Board members.
- 3.) A current civil action is pending regarding the legality of the application and installation of the met tower which to date has not gone to trial.
- 4.) Lastly, the former Planning Board has only allowed presentations by Antrim Wind Energy LLC and negated residents' numerous requests to have an unbiased qualified organization speak and present all information regarding the pros and cons of wind energy, and that they would not benefit financially by doing so.
