Background

Antrim Board of Adjustment (12 years -- alternate, member and chairman)

Antrim Planning Board (3 years as alternate, resigned when appointed to ConVal School Board)

Worked on a committee of nine community members (drawn from ZBA and PB) with Southwest Regional planner (hired by town) to overhaul the Antrim Zoning Ordinance in the late 1980s. Wrote zoning section on signage.

Master Plan Committee for plans adopted in 1980s and 2010 – wrote sections on public trails for earlier plan; wrote and researched chapter on “Community Facilities” for 2010 Master Plan.

Antrim Capital Improvement Committee (two years)

Attended town-wide community planning charette lead by David Essex in the 1990s.

Other experience

Current ConVal school board member and chairman of the board's Energy Subcommittee, which helped the district adopt the Energy Star Challenge.

Four ConVal schools will be named to the Energy Star list next month, which gives them national recognition for achieving significant reductions in their fuel consumptions and energy use. In addition, the ConVal district as a whole has seen a dramatic reduction in fuel consumption since Energy Subcommittee was formed in 2008.
