**3. Procedures.** Inquiries shall be in a question form and shall not be argumentative. Repetitive questions or inquiries will not be allowed. Questions and inquires to witnesses should be limited to issues pertaining to the witness's field of expertise and pre-filed testimony. Questions regarding qualifications of witnesses will also be allowed. If a proper question or inquiry cannot be answered at the time of the Technical Session, the Applicant will, in accordance with pre-trial scheduling order, prepare a written follow up answer and provide said written answers and responsive documents by July 12, 2012.

**4. Counsel for the Committee.** Counsel for the Committee will mediate any disputes regarding inquiries and requests for information and will maintain a list of documents that should be provided to the parties by July 12, 2012, in accordance with the pre-trial scheduling order. To the extent that any party is aggrieved by the handling of any inquiry, question or document request, that party shall file an appropriate motion for discovery, objection to discovery or motion for a protective order. Said motions and/or objections shall be directed to the presiding officer and shall comply with the Committee's Procedural Rules and the pre-trial order issued in this docket.
