I am writing you to voice my opposition against the proposed Wild Meadows Wind Farm. The continued population of wind turbines will grossly demean the natural beauty of the area, a resource that draws visitors and provides contentment to residents. In addition to the defacing of the ridge line by the turbines the larger transmission poles and lines that boarder the road ways are also unsightly. I believe this project would violate in part SB 191 "protect scenic landscape from being spoiled", and in part SB 99 "siting criteria to properly assure that the public interest is served in permitting new energy facilities in New Hampshire". Also, towns and its citizenry welcome conservation land so areas can be protected and remain unspoiled. Projects like these wind farms certainly reverse this objective.
