This is in response to your February 17, 2014 letter requesting a preliminary review of the New England Power (NEP) application for a new 230 kV Tap Line in Littleton, NH.

The NHDOT has received the application from the Applicant. We have reviewed the application and offer the following:

It appears at this time the Applicant has not determined if there will be any aspect of the construction of the project that will be subject to NHDOT jurisdiction. The Applicant indicated an application for an Oversize/Overweight Vehicle Permit will be submitted to the Department by NEP or its construction contractor if needed.

NEP indicated that access to the construction area will be via existing access point(s) on the PSNH Littleton Substation off Moore Court, thus not requiring a State drive permit.
