
At a public meeting on April 7, 2014, the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee (Committee) reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Site and Facility (Application) and voted to accept the Application as administratively complete. On April 15, 2014 a Subcommittee was designated pursuant to RSA 162-H: 4, V, to consider the Application in this docket. Vice Chairman Amy Ignatius was designated as the presiding officer in this matter. Pursuant to RSA 541-A: 31, V, a prehearing conference shall be held in this matter. Counsel to the Committee, Michael J. Iacopino, is hereby designated to preside at the prehearing conference. *See, NEW HAMPSHIRE CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES Site 202.10.*

This prehearing conference is authorized by RSA 541-A: 3, V (b) and NEW HAMPSHIRE CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES Site 202.10. The prehearing conference may include, but is not limited to, consideration of any one or more of the following:

- (1) Offers of settlement.
- (2) Simplification of the issues.
- (3) Stipulations or admissions as to issues of fact or proof, by consent of the parties.
- (4) Limitations on the number of witnesses.
- (5) Changes to standard procedures desired during the hearing, by consent of the parties.
- (6) Consolidation of examination of witnesses by the parties.
- (7) Scheduling.
- (8) Any other matters which aid in the disposition of the proceeding.

All parties to the proceedings and any person who has filed a motion to intervene in the proceedings should attend the prehearing conference.
