Dear Mr. Holden:

The Department of Environmental Services (DES) has reviewed your request to modify Wetland Permit condition #12 that would allow limited exceptions to the requirement of refueling equipment outside of wetland areas. DES agrees that repeated remobilization of certain types of equipment could cause additional wetland impact; therefore, this letter approves your request to modify Wetland Permit condition #12 and shall read as follows:

12. All refueling of equipment shall occur outside of surface waters or wetlands, except for long-duration equipment such as pulling machines, tensioning machines and auguring equipment.
