This email is to notify you that the DES Alteration of Terrain Bureau has reviewed the revised HER planting plan dated March 3, 2014 and finds that it meets the notification requirements of Administrative Rule Env-Wq 1503.21(d), whereby an amended permit or a new permit is unnecessary. Therefore, DES accepts the revisions as presented to allow for maintaining wider roadway widths and relocating the plantings to other areas that are less likely to be disturbed from future turbine maintenance (as identified in the field by NHF&G biologists).
