Data Requests:

1. Please provide the letter dated September 13, 2012 from Michael J. Iacopino to Craig Rennie, DES, concerning the need for an Amended Certificate.
2. Please provide a full sized copy of the plans that were presented and discussed at the technical session.
3. Please provide an overlay exhibit that demonstrates the plans as approved, as built and and as proposed for amendment.
4. Please provide a calculation demonstrating the aggregate increase in road-width (square footage) that will result if the Revised High Elevation Restoration Plan is approved.
5. Please provide a calculation demonstrating the aggregate decrease in the overall gravel surface if the Revised High Elevation Restoration Plan is approved.
6. Please provide all studies and periodic reports pertaining to wildlife, birds and bats that have been completed to date.
7. Please provide all correspondence between Granite Reliable Power, LLC and the Natural Heritage Bureau of the Department of Resources and Economic Development from August 2013 through the present day pertaining to the Granite Reliable Power Wind Farm.
8. Please provide a copy of the safety plan for the facility.

9. Please provide a calculation demonstrating the number of trees transferred from the lay down yards and switch yard to higher elevation areas.
10. Please provide a copy of the maintenance schedule for the turbines located on Mt. Kelsey.
