**AGENDA FOR TECHNICAL SESSION
ON OCTOBER 9, 2014**

A Technical Session will be held in this docket on October 9, 2014. The Technical Session shall begin at 11:00 A.M. The Technical Session shall be held in Hearing Room B at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 10, Concord N.H., 03301.

This Technical Session will be an informal opportunity for the parties to ask questions of the witnesses proffered by Counsel for the Public and Windaction.org. The following rules and procedures shall apply:

1. Schedule of Witnesses. During the Technical Session the Counsel for the Public's witnesses, Dr. Kirkpatrick and Christopher Gray will be available for questions as a panel. Ms. Linowes will be questioned thereafter.

2. Order of Inquiry. The order of inquiry shall be as follows:

- i. Counsel for the Public
- ii. Lisa Linowes, Windaction.org
- iii. County Commissioner Rick Samson

Counsel to the Committee will preside and will attempt to accommodate reasonable requests to adjust the order of inquiry.

3. Procedures. The Technical Session will be recorded verbatim. Inquiries shall be in a question form and shall not be argumentative. Repetitive questions or inquiries will not be allowed. Questions and inquires to witnesses should be limited to issues pertaining to the witness's field of expertise and pre-filed testimony. Questions regarding qualifications of witnesses will also be allowed. If a proper question or inquiry cannot be answered at the time of the Technical Session, the proffering party will provide a response in writing within seven (7) days unless otherwise ordered or agreed.

4. Counsel for the Committee. Counsel for the Committee will mediate disputes regarding any issues, inquiries and requests for information and will maintain a list of documents that should be provided to the parties after the technical session.

To the extent that any party is aggrieved by the resolution of any issue, inquiry, question or document request, that party shall file an appropriate motion for discovery or other relief or motion for a protective order. Said motions or other requests for relief shall be directed to the presiding officer and shall comply with the Committee's Procedural Rules and the pre-trial order issued in this docket.

Any party may bring a technical consultant to the session. The technical session will be recorded.

In addition the parties may also informally confer about outstanding issues in the docket and may informally discuss settlement, factual stipulations and scheduling matters.

The session is open to the public.
