MOTION TO INTERVENE *PRO SE* OF Janice Duley Longgood

Pursuant to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee Rules Site 202.11, Janice Duley Longgood hereby moves for permission to intervene *pro se* in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of her Motion to Intervene, Janice Duley Longgood offers the following arguments:

(1.) Janice Duley Longgood can demonstrate a substantial interest which may be affected by the outcome of the proceeding.

I am a direct abutter to the proposed site of the Antrim Wind Energy (AWE) facility. Due to the close proximity to my residence, I am extremely concerned about several factors. The AWE would have a long lasting impact on the rural quality of life that I have enjoyed for the past 29 years. My home was purchased with the protections of covenants, restrictions that ran with the land, those have since expired and the rural nature of the property has been protected by the Antrim Zoning Ordinances that prohibits this type of a project.

(2.) The interest of Janice Duley Longgood will not be adequately protected by other parties.

In exercising its discretion, I respectfully ask that the Committee consider whether the party's interest will be adequately protected by other parties. Since I, as a resident of the North Branch region of Antrim where the proposed wind facility would be constructed, am concerned that our interests have been fairly addressed thus far by the Town Boards of Antrim, I do not believe that any other party to this proceeding can adequately represent my interests in proceedings before the Committee. I have lived in the rural conservation district with protections for 29 years.


(3.) The intervention of Janice Duley Longgood will be in the interest of justice and will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings by allowing the intervention.

I petitioned for and was granted Intervener status in Antrim Wind Energy, LLC's prior cases before the Committee (SEC Dockets 2011-02 and 2012-01) and as such understand and respect the hearing process.

Pursuant to the SEC Order of December 30, 2014, Janice Duley Longgood files this Motion to Intervene by the deadline set forth by the Committee for Docket 2014-05 and requests that I be permitted to intervene with full standing to participate in all phases and activities of the proceeding. I respect the importance of conducting this proceeding in an orderly manner that will not unduly delay the Committee or the parties in reaching an outcome. I am prepared to work closely with other parties to the proceeding in the interest of maintaining order and respectfully offer that my participation, if permitted, would be in the interest of justice.
