Application of Antrim Wind Energy, LLC
for a Certificate of Site and Facility

ORDER APPOINTING SUBCOMMITTEE

On October 2, 2015, Antrim Wind Energy, LLC (Antrim Wind), filed an application for a certificate of site and facility (Application) with the Site Evaluation Committee (Committee).

Antrim Wind seeks the issuance of a Certificate of Site and Facility approving the siting, construction, and operation of a 28.8 MW electrical generation facility consisting of nine Siemens SWT-3.2-113 direct drive wind turbines and associated civil and electrical infrastructure. The entire project will be located in the northwest portion of the Town of Antrim.

The Application is currently under review for administrative completeness under RSA 162-H:7, VI.

Pursuant to RSA 162-H:4-a, the Chairperson of the Committee may establish subcommittees “to consider and make decisions on applications, including the issuance of certificates, or to exercise any other authority or perform any other duty of the committee” The subcommittee shall have no fewer than seven members when considering an application for site and facility. The subcommittee assumes the role of and is considered the committee, with all of its associated powers and duties in order to execute the charge given it by the chairperson.

In order to assure the prompt and efficient consideration of the Application, I hereby appoint the following Subcommittee:

1. Robert Scott, Commissioner, Public Utilities Commission, Chair of the Subcommittee and Presiding Officer;
2. Thomas Burack, Commissioner, Department of Environmental Services;
3. Kathryn M. Bailey, Commissioner, Public Utilities Commission;
4. Jeffrey Rose, Commissioner, Department of Resources and Economic Development;
5. Elizabeth Muzzey, Director, Division of Historical Resources;
6. Roger Hawk, Public Member; and
7. Patricia Weathersby, Public Member.

Pursuant to RSA 162-H:4-a, II, each state agency member may designate a senior administrative employee or staff attorney from his or her respective agency to sit in his or her place on the subcommittee. It is requested that the state agency members of the Subcommittee intending to designate a staff member do so, in writing to the attention of Pamela Monroe, Site Evaluation Committee Administrator, prior to October 26, 2015.

The Subcommittee is charged with resolving all issues that may arise in this docket and determining whether to grant or deny the application as filed.
