Dear Ms. Monroe:

In response to requests made by Parties in the above captioned docket, Antrim Wind Energy, LLC's ("AWE") provides the following update to the Committee and all Parties regarding Power Purchase Agreement ("PPA") negotiations as well as FAA lighting requirements.

PPA Status

On May 12, 2016 AWE entered into a 20-year power purchase agreement with New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc. for 25% of the energy and renewable energy credits (RECs) generated by the facility. The terms and conditions of this agreement are confidential. AWE is continuing to advance discussions for the remaining 75% of the energy and RECs from the facility and will keep the Committee and the Parties advised.

FAA Lighting

Subsequent to the issuance of FAA Advisory Circular 70/7460-1L in December 2015, AWE has been evaluating the requirements contained in the circular as well as available technology solutions in the marketplace. AWE's application describes AWE's commitment to utilize a radar activated lighting control system (called an Aircraft Detection Lighting System, or "ADLS" by the FAA), once approved by the FAA, and this commitment remains unchanged. In order to comply with the requirements of AC 70/7460-1L, it may be necessary to install a second radar unit at the facility.

AWE's evaluation of this issue is not yet complete and no internal determination has yet been made as to whether a second radar will be necessary. If a second radar unit ultimately becomes necessary, AWE will notify the Committee and amend its application as necessary. To the extent that a second radar is required, AWE does not expect that it will require significant

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changes to its application. AWE is providing this information in the interest of keeping the Committee and the public informed on its progress, as it understands that this is an area of interest.

AWE will provide the Committee and all Parties with additional updates as needed. Please let me know if you have any questions regarding this updated information.
