Dear Ms. Monroe – The attached letter responds to Acentech’s May 12, 2020 winter sound monitoring report for the Antrim Wind facility. Acentech failed to follow NH SEC rules in conducting its study and incorrectly applied the ANSI standard for long-term unattended monitoring. As such it is impossible to assess whether the Antrim turbines are operating in compliance with the NH SEC sound standard. I look forward to receiving the data requested in the letter.
