Good day, Ms. Donna Hanson,

First, I want to mention that we appreciate and welcome any questions and inquiries regarding Antrim Wind Energy.

The site is now undergoing a series of preventive maintenance and turbines will be occasionally paused to execute those (for short or longer period as required). Turbine 3 is currently paused as it is undergoing a maintenance that was required. Turbine 3 will be unpaused when the maintenance will be completed.

To our knowledge, the maintenance schedule is not a required deliverable to any third-party such as NHSEC or the Town. Also, as you know the Payment in Lieu of Taxes to the Town of Antrim remains unaffected by the normal maintenance such as the one ongoing. Nevertheless, we invite any stakeholders to submit any questions and inquiries to comments_antrimwindenergy@transalta.com which is a mailbox monitored by several staff members of Antrim Wind Energy LLC/TransAlta Corporation assuring a prompt response to all inquiries.

We hope this provides the necessary clarifications to the Town and Ms. Law.
