Dear Ms. Morrison-

On June 15, the Chair of the SEC sent the attached letter and revised protocol to Senator Ward, Senator Giuda, and Representative Vose. The letter is in response to constituent concerns provided to the Legislators in a letter that can be found at the following link: [https://www.nhsec.nh.gov/projects/2015-02/post-certificate-filings/2015-02\\_2020-04-17\\_ltr\\_chair\\_constituent\\_concerns.pdf](https://www.nhsec.nh.gov/projects/2015-02/post-certificate-filings/2015-02_2020-04-17_ltr_chair_constituent_concerns.pdf)

In your last correspondence, you raised concerns to me regarding Antrim Wind Energy being aware of when the testing would take place and manipulating the results. As provided on page 2 of the protocol, Site 301.18(i) requires the field studies to be conducted under the same meteorological conditions as occurred at the time of the alleged exceedance that is the subject of the complaint. The forecasted conditions in the measurement scheduling section of the protocol (also on page 2), were developed based upon a review of the data by Mr. Tocci, the third-party expert, during periods when noise complaints were received. It is necessary for Antrim Wind to provide the forecasts so that the measurements can take place when the forecasted conditions arise. It is my understanding that it is also necessary that Antrim Wind provide notice to and receive permission from, the Independent System Operator of NE (operator of the electrical grid) in order to shutdown the turbines for the 30-minute period specified on page 4 of the protocol.

By way of this e-mail, I am requesting your permission to conduct a site visit to your property with Mr. Tocci and his staff, myself, and Ethan Mollasalehi, from Antrim Wind. Ms. Berwick did not allow the Antrim Wind representative to attend the site visit when we went to her property back in February, but I will leave that decision to you and, of course, I will honor whatever you decide.

The purpose of the site visit is to meet you, talk about the measurement effort, answer any questions, and to determine where the sound monitoring equipment would be set-up in order to take the measurements when the forecasted conditions arise. We will follow all CDC guidelines for social distancing and wearing masks. Mr. Tocci is checking his availability, but I would tentatively propose this Friday, June 26, Monday, June 29, Tuesday, June 30, or Wednesday, July 1. Please let me know what works best for you.

I look forward to your response.
