Re: Antrim Wind Energy – RPR 3291 – Completion of the Memorandum of Understanding stipulations

Dear Ms. Nadine Miller,

The current letter relates to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that has been agreed between the NHSHPO and the Antrim Wind Energy LLC (AWE). The MOU was assembled and executed following AWE's application for a wind energy facility located in Antrim, Hillsborough county (NH). The execution and implementation of the MOU resolves the facility's effects on the White Birch Point Historic District (as those terms are defined in the MOU) and which MOU is appended to and a condition of the Certificate¹ of Site and Facility issued by the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee to AWE.

The original MOU was executed by NHSHPO on August 10, 2016 and by AWE on August 15, 2016. A first amendment was done on July 22, 2019 to adjust the deadlines to allow the necessary time to continue engaging with the White Birch Point Association. Following the consultation with the White Birch Point Association leaded by the Architectural Historian (hired by AWE), a second amendment which adjusted the stipulations was done on December 18, 2019. The new stipulations were to reflect a mutually agreeable project with a scope for rehabilitation work on the former mail shelter structure and enhancement of the White Birch Point entrance.

We are pleased to confirm that the scope per the second amendment of the MOU was completed on June 16, 2019. For your convenience, we have attached to this letter pictures showing the mail shelter before and after the rehabilitation work as well as one showing the new white birch tree.


