On Monday, August 22, 2016, the Stoddard Selectmen met with their Conservation Commission to discuss the latest version of the Antrim Wind Project. At the conclusion of the presentation by the Conservation Commission the Board voted unanimously to support the Conservation Commission's intervenor status.

The proposed project disturbs a significant wildlife area which is centered on Stoddard and also has a significant visual impact to large portions of our community. All of this without providing any benefit, financial or otherwise, to our property owners and residents.

Stoddard is a town that derives much of it's present value and quality of life from having large tracts of land that have been voluntarily set aside for conservation purposes. This project will only serve to have a negative impact on these values. We respectfully request that the Site Evaluation Committee consider the negative impact this project will have for Stoddard during it's decision process.
