Three years ago we had written to the Site Evaluation Committee to express our opposition to the proposed Antrim Wind Energy project and gratitude to the Committee for its decision to deny the construction of the project at that time.

We are aware that the Wind Energy proposal has been "modified" and is, once again, before your Committee for approval. The modifications proposed to the project have done little to alter the adverse effect it would have on the Gregg Lake area or our opposition to it.

We have had a home on Gregg Lake for the last ten years where we had planned to retire. We were attracted to the area because of its natural beauty and limited development. The physical presence of the proposed wind turbines would drastically change the area, adversely affecting the natural beauty of the Lake and the mountain ridge.

Of equal concern is the noise the turbines would generate. Gregg Lake is located in a shallow bowl surrounded by elevated land. It is very easy to hear the sound of a human voice from across the lake. The complex acoustic sound that would be generated by multiple large wind turbines in this environment has not been addressed and is of great concern to us and others that live in the immediate vicinity of the Lake.

The Site Evaluation Committee has declined to authorize this project in the past and the people of Antrim overwhelmingly voted against it. The modifications proposed provide very little relief, if any, from the original proposal and we respectfully request that this project continue to receive your denial.
