I have lived in Antrim for 30 yrs.. I enjoy its rural setting and have supported zoning ordinances that protect landowners from large scale business projects where they don't belong... the Antrim Wind Farm is such a project...It doesn't belong in a Rural Conservation District ...Lets review the definition ...

"The Rural Conservation District is intended to protect,conserve and preserve the remote mountainous portions of Antrim from excessive development pressures and / or activities that would be detrimental to the unique environmental characteristics and qualities of this district...and detract from the PEACEFUL ENJOYMENT and TRANQUILITY that this district affords local residents..."

Those words were specifically chosen to attract and keep the kind of residents a small town like Antrim wants...Zoning laws are promises that must be kept... When the selectmen attempted to change the zoning to allow the Wind Farm, the town voted at the ballot box not once but, twice NOT to change the

zoning ...So, the Antrim Selectman petitioned your committee to intervene knowing very well that it is within your power to change the "rules" if you so deem this project necessary ...
