**I strongly oppose approval of the Antrim Wind Energy LLC proposal. The energy benefit, as projected in testimony, seems minimal. A major concern is the proximity of the proposed windfarm to the dePierrefeu-Willard Pond Wild Life Sanctuary and the “supersanctuary” created by adjacent protected properties. It’s an isolated spot that I’ve enjoyed during my decades as a NH resident and teacher. Countless others get the same benefit. Please save it for future generations.**

**I also sympathize with families who are neighbors to this site. The proposal would negatively impact their ability to enjoy their own property. Their fears came true for many on Cape Cod as I learned from friends/family, this summer. They are effected by an existing windfarm that abuts Route 25 on the approach to Cape Cod’s Bourne Bridge.**
