

To the SEC Sub Committee deciding Antrim Wind Energy LLC -

We are writing to voice our opposition to the Antrim Wind project currently under consideration for granting of a certificate by your Committee. The project already was denied for aesthetic concerns. The omission of one tower and a reduction in height results in little modification to make a significant difference. The project is out of scale for the Antrim area - period.

The SEC will set a bad precedence if it allows developers to return to the Committee in search of a favorable outcome when circumstances don't go in their favor the first time around. In the case of Antrim Wind, there is little justification for this large taking of time, energy and expense, both for Committee members and interveners.

Industrial Wind's performance in New Hampshire is lackluster, especially when the addition of parasitic loss is included. The negative impact of building such wind facilities on our state's ridgelines far outweighs any benefit. There are other renewables that are better choices. Please consider this when future energy projects come before you for approval.
