Dear Ms. Monroe:

On behalf of the Applicant Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") we are submitting herewith various historical resources survey forms that have been completed and reviewed by the Division of Historical Resources since the Application for the Seacoast Reliability Project was filed with the SEC on April 12, 2016. Pursuant to the Site Evaluation Committee's April 6, 2016 *Order on Procedural Waiver Request*, we are submitting two paper copies of these survey forms and ten electronic copies for the Subcommittee, and electronic copies to the towns and to Counsel for the Public. I have also enclosed my Appearance in this proceeding.

These documents include the following individual inventory forms and historic district area forms:


- Adams Homestead, 148 Nimble Hill Rd, Newington
- Benjamin Hoyt House, 97 Nimble Hill Rd, Newington
- Durham Point Historic District, Durham
- Gosling Meadows Housing Development, Portsmouth
- Orcutt Development Area, Durham
- Stone House Farm, Durham
- UNH Historic District Form

All of these forms have been submitted to and reviewed by the Division of Historical Resources ("DHR". Four have been fully accepted. The Stone House Road form has also been accepted for eligibility purposes, we understand, but cannot be fully processed due to our inability to obtain access to the property to take photographs of the historic structures. DHR's Determination of Eligibility Committee ("DOE Committee") reviewed the UNH district form yesterday, and our understanding is that it was accepted. The Durham Point Historic District form is a revised version of a form submitted earlier

At this juncture, I understand that the only open question that remains to be addressed by DHR is whether the revised form for the Durham Point Historic District will be accepted by DHR. With the submission of all of the required inventory forms, including one revised form, we believe that we have satisfied the completeness requirements in RSA 162-H and in the SEC's rules. We know that time is short between now and the Subcommittee's meeting on June 1, but we hope that DHR will be able to provide a positive report to the Subcommittee on the status of the Applicant's final submittal.
