- I, Barry Needleman, being duly sworn, do under oath depose and state as follows:
- 1. I am a Director at McLane Middleton, Professional Association, which represents Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy in the above-captioned matter.
- 2. Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") proposes to construct an approximately 12.9-mile 115 kV transmission line from Madbury Substation in Madbury, New Hampshire to Portsmouth Substation in Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

- 6. Pursuant to the Order, a Notice of Public Information Session for Strafford
 County and Rockingham County was published in the New Hampshire Union Leader on August
 11, 2016, a newspaper of regular circulation in each County, which meets the August 21, 2016
 deadline.
