## **NOTICE OF HEARING AND DELIBERATIONS**

This notice schedules a hearing and deliberations on a pending motion and any other matter that is lawfully before the Subcommittee.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On April 12, 2016, the Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy filed an Application for a Certificate of Site and Facility with the Site Evaluation Committee. The Application seeks the issuance of a Certificate of Site and Facility approving the siting, construction, and operation of a new 115kV electric transmission line between existing substations in Madbury and Portsmouth (Project.) The proposed transmission line will be approximately 12.9 miles in length and is comprised of a combination of above ground, underground and underwater segments, located in the Towns of Madbury and Durham in Strafford County, and the Town of Newington and the City of Portsmouth in Rockingham County.

On August 21, 2017, an Order on the Applicant's Motion to Postpone Final Adjudicative Hearings was issued, suspending the schedule for the adjudicative hearing as well as the procedural schedule in this docket.

On November 22, 2017, the Town of Newington filed a Partially Assented-To Motion to Consult with ISO-New England. On December 4, 2017, the Applicant objected.

The Subcommittee will conduct a hearing and public deliberations on the pending motion on Wednesday, March 14, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. at 49 Donovan Street, Concord, New Hampshire. At the hearing, the Subcommittee may allow the parties to supplement the written motion and objection with oral argument, if necessary. If there are any other matters that are lawfully before the Subcommittee, those matters will also be considered.

## Directions to 49 Donovan Street, Concord, NH

From I-93 North or South, take exit 12N for NH-3A/South Main Street. Merge onto NH-3A-N/South Main Street. Turn left onto Joffre Street and then turn left at the first cross-street onto Donovan Street. Follow to the end of Donovan Street and the building is on your left.
