**3. Procedures.** Inquiries shall be in a question form and shall not be argumentative.

Repetitive questions or inquiries will not be allowed. Questions and inquiries to witnesses should be limited to issues pertaining to the witness's field of expertise and pre-filed testimony,

and should be within the scope of the adjudicative proceeding. Questions regarding qualifications of the witnesses will also be allowed. **4.
