Response to Applicants' Response and Objection to Certain
Petitions to Intervene, dated February 26, 2016

We would like to take this opportunity to respond to the Applicant's objection to our right to intervene. We reiterate that we feel it is unfair to exclude us based upon our previous stated reason that Northern Pass executives have failed to formally withdraw its originally preferred route. Should this route be resurrected for some presently unknown reason, we would be unduly harmed by being shut out of the the aforementioned proceedings.

Moreover, it is further acknowledged that Northern Pass executives employ a complete double standard by not objecting to the intervention petitions filed by the IBEW, the Nashua Chamber of Commerce, and the Manchester Chamber of Commerce.

We respectfully request that the members of the Site Evaluation Committee rule in favor of our right to Petition to Intervene in the Northern Pass proceedings.
