RE: Technical Session Data Requests

A technical session was held on October 18, 2016, in the above referenced docket. The purpose of the technical sessions is for the parties to inquire of the Applicant's witnesses their expertise, opinions and pre-filed testimony. The parties that were present during all or part of the technical sessions on each day are listed on the sign-in sheets that are attached to this memorandum. Peter Roth, Counsel for the Public, and his attorney, Eli Emerson were both present.

At the conclusion of the technical sessions, the following data requests to the Applicant remain outstanding:

1. Provide documents confirming that the Army Corps of Engineers concurred with Normandeau's delineation of natural resources (Page 3, Line 2 of Ms. Carbonneau's pre-filed testimony).
2. Provide any documents that exist, that memorialize the ongoing discussions that the Project is having with the one potential conservation easement holder (Page 6, Lines 26 and 27 of Ms. Carbonneau's pre-filed testimony).
3. Provide the dates of the photos as well as the scale that was used in the wildlife habitat assessment report (Appendix 36).
4. Provide the vernal pool habitat assessment forms that Normandeau completed for the Project.
5. Provide copies of all of the wetlands function and values forms that were completed for the Project by Normandeau.

6. Provide a copy of the letter or any other documentation, if any exists, from the landowner to the Applicant that indicates that the wetlands impacts at Transition Station #5, cannot be avoided due to the lack of permission from the landowner to transfer this real estate to the Applicant. In the alternative, provide any other documents that are related to the property surrounding Transition Station #5.
7. Provide an explanation as to why construction cannot be avoided in the vernal pool shown on sheet 658, identified as DF63, of the wetlands maps.
8. Provide the list of all of the wells and other water supplies that have been identified along the project route from the DES database (Applicant states that this is most likely confidential information).
