RE: Technical Session Data Requests

Technical sessions were held on February 8 and 14, 2017, in the above referenced docket. The purpose of the technical sessions is for the parties to inquire of the witnesses for Counsel for the Public and the Intervenors as to their expertise, opinions, and pre-filed testimony. The parties that were present during all or part of the technical sessions on these dates are listed on the sign-in sheets that are attached to this memorandum.

At the conclusion of the technical sessions, the following data requests to the Intervenors remain outstanding:

Feb. 8-Counsel for the Public-David Taylor, Adam Zysk, and Brenden Alexander-Dewberry

1. Provide a list of any alleged or actual violations of either OSHA or environmental regulations for all the transmission line projects overseen by Dewberry and listed in response to data request CFA-I.3.
2. Provide any notes or minutes of internal meetings that were held to discuss and assess the project application.
3. Provide all drafts of the November 15, 2016 Report, and all e-mails containing substantive changes and comments related to the Report.

Feb. 14-Concord, Bridgewater, Deerfield, Littleton, New Hampton, Pembroke, Ashland Water & Sewer Dept., Bristol, Franconia, Northumberland, Plymouth, Sugar Hill, and Whitefield-George Sansoucy, P.E.

1. Provide a list of the written testimony that Mr. Sansoucy submitted in regulatory proceedings before the FERC, as referred to on Page 1, Line 17 of the pre-filed testimony.

2. Provide all documents that Mr. Sansoucy created for the “Maine Case” (i.e. the NE Energy Link project and related legislation) that he then relied upon for purposes of his pre-filed testimony.
3. Provide copies of all of the standards (state, federal, electrical codes, etc.) that Mr. Sansoucy relied upon in developing the statements his pre-filed testimony (for instance, beginning on Page 11, Line 10) and how the proposed project is inconsistent with those standards (as it relates to the location, depth, etc.).
4. Provide a copy of the study that Mr. Sansoucy’s company conducted on the impact on property values of the proposed power line and power plant in Burrillville, RI.

The foregoing shall be provided to all of the parties on or before February 27, 2017. Copies shall not be provided to the Committee. To the extent that the Intervenor objects to providing the above referenced material, the requesting party must file a Motion to Compel with the Committee.
