I live and own property in Thornton, NH and write a Keeping Each Other Well column for NH newspapers (Salmon Press). My research for my column includes both the health effects of

- Above-ground power lines, especially AC/DC parallel lines, and
- Inadequate offset of the carbon footprint created by Hydro Quebec for its power, through destruction of Quebec. I hope to guard against possible similar consequences to NH should this project be approved. (Please see my 1/11/16 Comment letter to SEC).
