We own a property, known as the Bungay Jar, located on Route 116, in the town of Easton, in Grafton County, New Hampshire, which **abuts the currently proposed route** of the Northern Pass transmission line.

Issues of principal concern to us include:

**Legal right to location.** Eversource/Northern Pass has not shown us that they have a legal right to locate this type of transmission line on or along our property.


**Property value.** We are concerned that the project will diminish the value of our property.
